

How Award Recipient is Chosen

The recipient will be chosen based on a combination of 3 categories: Irrigation Products and Practices, Landscape Material, and Reduction of Water Consumption (if applicable) or Annual Usage. All requirements must be met to be considered. Residents that have utilized the City's Water Conservation Incentive Program to retro-fit their irrigation systems will automatically be considered for the award. In addition, residents that have not utilized the Incentive Program may be considered for the award by submitting an application of the water conserving practices being used. An evaluation of the residents landscape, irrigation system, and water usage will be conducted. The City must have a minimum of 3 months of water consumption data to be eligible. Points will be awarded based on the water conserving products and practices utilized, average water consumption, and the material and condition of the landscape.

Deadline in April 8, 2009

Award presentation will be held at the Earth Day Celebration on April 18, 2009.

1st prize \$100 credit to utility bill

2nd prize \$50 credit to utility bill
