

RESOLUTION NO. 2004-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, TO CHANGE THE CITY STREET NAME KNOWN AS "RECREATION WAY" TO "JASON DWELLEY PARKWAY", AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 53, PAGE 146, OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Apopka Code of Ordinances, Part III, Land Development Code, Article VI, Section 6.02.02(F), Administrative street name changes may be directed to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, The Dwelley family has long been a valued member of the Apopka community; and

WHEREAS, Jason Bosley Dwelley a 1990 graduate of Apopka High School joined the United States Navy in 1994; and

WHEREAS, While in the Navy Jason received several medals, including the Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, two Armed Forces Expeditionary Medals, five Battle E's, and two Sea Service Deployment Ribbons; and

WHEREAS, As a naval reservist preparing to attend the University of Central Florida, Jason was called up to active duty in February of 2004; and

WHEREAS, Jason was deployed to the War in Iraq in April of 2004; and

WHEREAS, On April 30, 2004, at 8:35 p.m., Jason was killed in the service of his country; and

WHEREAS, The City of Apopka would like to recognize his contributions to the safety, security, and freedom of our nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, that "RECREATION WAY" as described below and as shown on Exhibit "A" shall from this day forward be renamed to "JASON DWELLEY PARKWAY":

The North/South segment of the "Recreation Way" right-of-way as recorded in Plat Book 53, Page 146, of the Public Records of Orange County, Florida; more particularly that portion of Recreation Way located north of Ponkan Road to its current terminus in Section 20, Township 20 South, Range 28, East.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be presented to John and Quennell Dwelley expressing the sorrow that is felt by all Apopka citizens over the loss of their son Jason; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the appropriate City and County agencies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of the adoption of this Resolution No. 2004-13 be published and the Resolution be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Orange County, Florida, and duly recorded among the Public Records of Orange County, Florida;
